







## More than just a historical city in East Sussex

Hastings today is a delightful mixture of history, culture, museums, shops of every description, visitor attractions and good restaurants and pubs. Whether you are planning to shop, eat, relax on the beach, visit the castle or a museum or simply wander around, you will enjoy your stay and will want to come again and again, like so many visitors we welcome to Hastings every year.

Hastings castle is located in the town centre, on West Hill, 36 miles east of Brighton, on the A 27. It was originally an earth and timber\* improvised fortress, founded in 1066 by William of Normandy. In the 13th century, it changed a lot with the addition of the South Tower and a twin towered gatehouse. Sadly, erosion by the sea has consumed more than half of the original castle.

The site is open daily,

- April to September 11 a.m.-4 p.m.,
- October to March 10 a.m.-3:30 p.m.

Car parking is by the site off the road.
